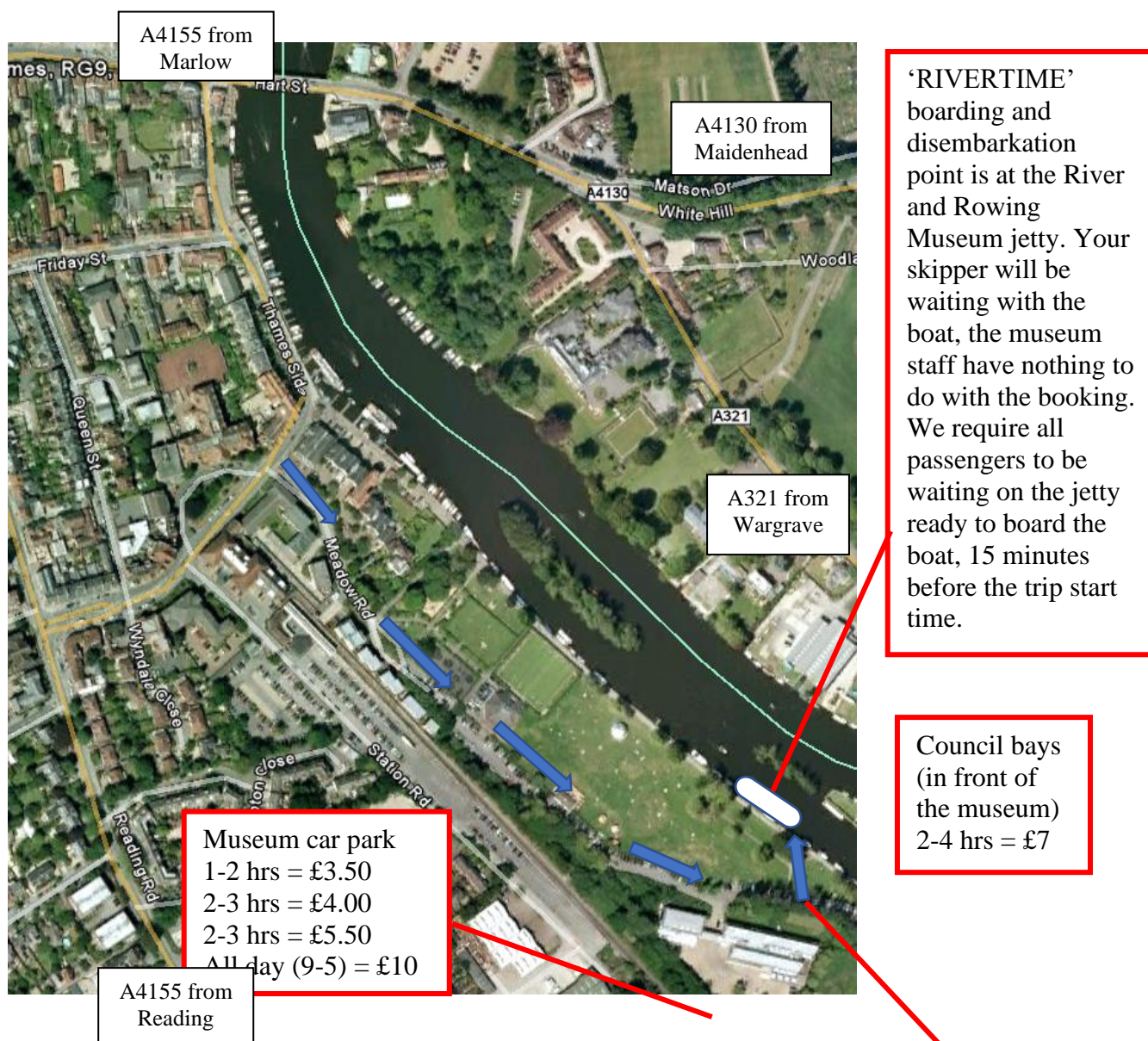

Please ensure all those involved in organising your day are given a copy of this information. If you have a weekend booking, please check for events happening in Henley and leave plenty of time.

Take meadow road and follow it all the way to the end where you will find parking spaces in front of the museum building. If you are a blue badge holder you can park for free in the disabled bays (outlined in yellow) The ideal bay is next to the path that leads you to the boat and is marked with a wheelchair symbol on the map. See below for the museum car park charges.

As we are sharing the jetty with other boat operators, we require all passengers to be waiting on the jetty ready to board the boat, 15 minutes before the trip start time. Carers / support staff will be required to assist all members of their group during the boarding process. If you are running late, please call your skipper. 'RIVERTIME' boarding and disembarkation point is at the River and Rowing Museum Jetty. Your skipper will be waiting with the boat, the museum staff have nothing to do with the booking. We require all passengers to be waiting on the jetty ready to board the boat, 15 minutes before the trip start time.

Council bays (in front of the museum) 2-4 hrs = £7

1-2 hrs = £3.50
2-3 hrs = £4.00
