



Covid-19 Risk Register

Area	Risk	Control Measures/ Mitigation
Greeting customers on the jetty	Direct Covid-19 virus transfer, due to close proximity to others	Clients to arrive at their allocated boarding time. Wherever possible, a distance of 2m to be maintained between the customers and RBT personnel.
Fitting and cleaning of buoyancy aids.	Direct Covid-19 virus transfer, due to close proximity to others. Indirect Covid-19 virus transferred to common contact surfaces	RBT personnel to give clear instructions on how to fit buoyancy aids, supervising from an appropriate distance. After use, buoyancy aids will be dated and labelled and not used again for 72 hours.
Boarding and disembarking the vessel	Direct Covid-19 virus transfer, due to close proximity to others	RBT personnel to give clear guidance on how to board the vessel. Skipper and crew will be there to help when necessary.
On the vessel	Direct Covid-19 virus transfer, due to close proximity to others	Screens have been fitted around the helm position and the galley Clients to remain seated wherever possible. Face coverings to be worn when moving around the boat. Both customers and RBT personnel to use sanitiser upon entry to the boat and following any personal contact.
Unmanned Lock	Indirect Covid-19 virus transferred to common contact surfaces	RBT personnel to self-sanitise hands after operating the lock pedestal.
Cleaning of the vessel and equipment in preparation for the next outing.	Indirect Covid-19 virus transferred to common contact surfaces	All touch points to be sanitized after each trip. Upholstery to be steam cleaned. Buoyancy aids sanitised after use.
